

Rounding

Steps/Rules to Rounding:

1) Find the place value you need to round to, and underline it (if it helps you):

a. Round 59,786 to the Hundreds Position

i. 59, 7 86

2) Keep all values in front of the place you are rounding the same/ separate

a. 59, 7 86 => 59,000 + 786

3) Look to the number to the right of the place value you are rounding to determine if you round up or down:

a. If the value is >5 then you will round the digit up to the next value

b. If the value is <5 then you will keep the digit the same

i. Ex. 7 86 = 8 > 5 so 7 => 8 but if it were 7 46 = 4 < 5
so 7 = 7

4) Every value after the digit to which you are rounding becomes zero

a. 786 = 800

5) Add your new value into the preserved value from step #2

a. 59,000 + 800 = 59,800
